FOREGILL BRIDGE – EMERGENCY STABILISATION WORKS – FULL ROAD CLOSURE

This letter is to inform you that North Yorkshire Council, will be undertaking emergency works to stabilise the retaining wall failure at Foregill Bridge, Arkle Town.

The emergency works are currently programmed to commence on 16th January 2024 and will be carried out under a full road closure for a period of up to 3 days. Whilst the works are in progress, a fully signed diversion will be in place. The diversion is only suitable for cars. Heavy goods vehicles should find a suitable alternative route or suspend any plans that require use of the road for the duration of the closure. A plan showing the extent of the works is enclosed for your information.

The works aim to stabilise the failure to allow the road to remain open whilst a more robust permanent repair scheme for the structure can be organised for summer 2024.

Please note, this is an emergency scheme therefore some adjustment to this start date or the duration of the works may be necessary should unforeseen circumstances such as significant weather events or emergencies on the highway network arise. The forecast weather conditions prior to the closure will be monitored on Monday the 15th January. If any sign of significant weather events are forecast during the works then the emergency works and road closure will be suspended.

To ensure the delivery of these works we request your assistance in the following ways:

- Please contact the Customer Service Centre on 0300 131 2 131, to identify any special access needs you may have prior to work commencing.
- Please co-operate and comply with any instructions issued by the traffic management operatives and take extra care whilst within the works area.
